

### DETROIT LEADERSHIP ACADEMY COVID-19 PREPAREDNESS PLAN FOR 2021-2022

DLA created this plan\* for the 21-22 school year in order to provide direction from both medical and scientific experts on COVID-19 safety and health equity, which will assist the school community in reaching the goal of sustaining in-person learning and wellness for our students and employees. The strategies below are based on the COVID-19 transmission levels as defined by the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) on their COVID Data Tracker website. DLA will base its preventative measures and response on the CDC reported transmission level for the city of Detroit, any health or executive orders from the state, as well as regular and ongoing communications with officials from the Detroit Health Department.

\*This plan is subject to change and will evolve as the COVID-19 science and information does. Any changes to the plan due to updates from the CDC and local or state officials will be posted on the <u>DLA website</u> under the family resources tab. Adjustments in protocols will be determined by the school administration. Unless there are extenuating circumstances, adjustments in mitigation measures will take place on Mondays, immediately following any new guidance.

## **Isolation and Quarantine (Staff & Students)**

DLA will work with the City of Detroit Health Department to support case investigation and the contact tracing process. DLA will provide educational support for students and families who are impacted by isolation and quarantine. Isolation and quarantine will adhere to local public health requirements and operating procedures. Close contact identification will be supported by the school for classroom and athletic-based close contact identification.

NOTES: Close contact exclusion will be determined by current school operations and policies currently in place for masking and social distancing. For example:

- → If no masks required. Close contacts within 6 ft. of a positive individual for 15 or more cumulative minutes will be quarantined for 10 days from the last date of contact. Fully vaccinated individuals **do not** quarantine unless the individual displays symptoms.
- → If Face masks required. Close contacts within 3 ft. of a positive individual for 15 or more cumulative minutes will be quarantined for 10 days from the last date of contact. Individuals 3 to 6 ft. may continue to attend school as long as they do not have symptoms. Fully vaccinated individuals do not quarantine unless the individual displays symptoms.

#### **Vaccinations**

The CDC & DLA both recommend vaccinations to help stop the spread of COVID-19 and other communicable disease.

DLA is **NOT** requiring staff or students to be vaccinated.

### **COVID Testing**

COVID testing of students or staff <u>will not be required</u> unless mandated by a local or state agency and/or a sanctioning body.

Athlete & extracurricular participant testing <u>will not be required</u> unless mandated by a local or state agency and/or a sanctioning body.

Optional COVID testing will be provided on a weekly basis at both the K-8 and HS campuses.

### **Student Health Screening and Illness**

Parents/guardians should conduct a daily <u>self-check</u> and student <u>wellness check</u> prior to sending student(s) to school. Attendance policies may be waived or suspended. **PO NOT SEND SICK STUDENTS TO SCHOOL.**
